starring Vince Gill with Ashley Monroe, Charlie Worsham and Jenny Gill  
in Downtown El Dorado AR, March 19<sup>th</sup>**


El Dorado – *Main Street El Dorado* will present **Vince Gill & Friends** live on Thursday, March 19<sup>th</sup> at the *El Dorado Municipal Auditorium* (100 W 8<sup>th</sup> El Dorado, AR). The concert, which will also feature rising country stars *Ashley Monroe, Charlie Worsham & Jenny Gill* begins at 7:00 PM with doors opening at 6:00 PM.

*Vince Gill* is one of the most active and awarded performers in modern-day music. Gill has recorded more than 20 studio albums, charted over 40 singles on the *US Billboard* charts and has sold more than 26 million albums worldwide. He has been honored by the Country Music Association with 18 *CMA Awards*, including two *Entertainer of the Year* awards and five *Male Vocalist of the Year* awards. *Gill* has also earned 20 *Grammy Awards*, more than any other male country music artist. He was inducted into the *Country Music Hall of Fame* in 2007 and received his own star on the *Hollywood Walk of Fame* in 2012. In addition to the nearly two dozen albums he has recorded as a solo artist, he has been a guest artist on nearly 1,000 albums by other singers in virtually all genres of popular music. Married to music star Amy Grant, Gill was recently declared a BMI Icon, an honor reserved for the most influential songwriters. He is also a member of the Grammy-nominated Nashville supergroup, The Time Jumpers.



*Ashley Monroe* is a singer/songwriter signed to *Warner Brothers Nashville*. Her second studio album, *Like a Rose*, was produced by *Vince Gill* and reached #10 on the *US Country Albums* charts after being met by widespread critical acclaim. In 2011, Monroe teamed with longtime friends *Miranda Lambert* and *Angaleena Presley* to form the *Pistol Annies*. The trio’s debut, *Hell on Heels*, reached #1 on the *US Country Albums* charts and the group was nominated for *New Artist of the Year* at the *American Country Awards*. *Monroe* is featured on *Bruises*, a 2012 duet with *Train*’s singer *Pat Monohan*. She and *Monohan* starred in the video and she toured with *Train* on the *Mermaids of Alcatraz Tour* in the summer of 2013.

On stage *Charlie Worsham* proves that to him, “Music is the only thing.” Raised in Grenada, Mississippi, *Worsham* is a ridiculously talented multi-instrumentalist and student of great songs. He studied music at Berklee College of Music in Boston and developed a unique modern country sound built around the traditional acoustic instruments he grew up on. With his smash hit, “*Could It Be*,” making a name for himself in the country music world, *Worsham* hit the scene hard performing with country greats like *Miranda Lambert, Wade Bowen*, and many



more. Becoming more and more of a “Hot Ticket”, Worsham toured with Taylor Swift in 2011, featured *Vince Gill* and *Marty Stuart* on his recording of “*Tools of the Trade*” and more recently appeared on an episode of the Fox TV series, *Bones*, that also sound-tracked his song, “*Love Don’t Die Easy*.”



*Jenny Gill is the daughter of Country Music Hall of Fame member Vince Gill and Janis Oliver of Sweethearts of the Rodeo. Jenny performs as a backup vocalist for Amy Grant and is a solo performer and professional songwriter with her own unique country sound and smooth harmonies. Growing in popularity, Jenny recently hosted the internationally syndicated Teen Country radio show, tours with many country greats and all the while graduated at Middle Tennessee State University and just became a mommy with her husband Josh Van Valkenburg to their new son Wyatt Gill Van Valkenburg.*
